- Adhering to all NCAA, ODAC and sport rules and regulations.
- Serving as game administrator at intercollegiate contests as assigned by the department and/or assisting in other assigned duties in support of the department and program.

- Experience at the intercollegiate level is preferred.
- Valid driver's license and a clear driving record required.
